

Parade Competition Rule Changes – 2007

The PCR Committee met recently to discuss proposed changes that would affect 2007. From the list of membership proposals and/or comments as well as the Committee's own list of changes, we compiled a list of proposed changes for 2007. Below is a summary of the proposed changes that will take effect as of January 1, 2007. Comments on these changes will be accepted until December 1, 2006. At that time, the PCR Committee will make a final decision on the proposals. For a more complete text of the changes, please see the PCA website ([www.pca.org](http://www.pca.org)).

Concours – add five years to the Preservation Group timeline (Y to Y-15 with Y being the current year), split the Preservation 911 Division into two divisions (early/late), provide specific plan for consolidation (pooling) of classes in Restoration and Preservation in the absence of a minimum of three automobiles, clarify judging procedures for split classes (has been listed as “split divisions”)

Rally – add a definition for the word “AT”, add that the rally will be a minimum of 3.5 hours long

Autocross – add the new Cayman to S05 and P15, add the 997 Club Coupe to S12 and P13, clarify that headers are permitted in the Production classes, remove open and semi-open automobile wording and clarify that entrants must wear helmets with face shields in any automobile without a full windshield, change window rules to state that entrants must have their driver's/passenger's windows either fully up or fully down

Tech Quiz – modify the tech quiz name to recognize that the quiz also contains historical questions, alter wording to show that the quiz (not including the tie-breakers) may be comprised with a minimum of 50 to a maximum of 100 questions, add the PCA Historian to list of those reviewing the quiz
